## Robyn Golden-Hann



The celebrated stonemason Robyn Golden-Hann has been commissioned to mark the centenary of the formation of the Women's Royal Naval Service and women's service in the Royal Navy by carving a commemorative stone.

Using the very traditional and instantly recognisable Portland stone, her work will depict the unique shapes of female naval uniform hats of the past 100 years. Robyn says,
